The European policy for Circular Economy transforms economies and societies in a way that resources are retained in the production loop for as long as possible. The transition towards a circular, low-carbon economy is an agenda for environmental change, preserving competitiveness, jobs, growth and social cohesion. The Circular Economy Action Plan of the European Union has implemented more than 80% of the actions foreseen. Significant policy initiatives were adopted within 2018. Currently, citizens, businesses and governments in Europe discuss the continuation and expansion of new measures promoting circularity following the forthcoming completion of the 2015 Action Plan.
