Career history

After graduating as a Mathematics PhD and following post-doctoral studies and a course in Nuclear Engineering, Dr. Sunil Felix was hired at the French Atomic Energy and Alternative Energies Commission (CEA) in 1990.

His research activities focused on Structural Analysis, mainly mathematical modelling of the thermo-mechanical behavior of nuclear reactor components under accidental conditions.

Throughout his career, Dr. Felix performed research activities in France as well as abroad (Japan), and also served as Nuclear Counsellor at the French Embassy in several countries (South Korea, India, Japan). He also served as personal assistant to the President of the Generation IV International Forum, the GIF, aimed at promoting multilateral cooperation in the field of fourth generation nuclear reactors.
